Celebration of Mass

Church will be open for the celebration of Mass on the following days and times:

Please note – Mass will be celebrated for the first time on Saturday 4th July

If you are able to attend Mass it is important that we adhere to the Government's 'Covid-19 Secure' guidelines which will allow you to remain safe and avoid transmission of the virus. It is recommended that if you have serious underlying health conditions or who have a temperature or cold or flu-like symptoms you should not visit church at the present time.

For social distancing we have adopted the 1metre+ requirement which means that it is compulsory to wear a face covering – a mask or scarf – to cover the mouth and nose if attending Mass.

Our church will be managed in a safe and secure manner as follows –

- A maximum of 80 people will be able to attend a Mass;
- Church will open 30 minutes before the time of Mass and Stewards will direct you to seating to ensure that we maintain the 'social distancing' rules;
- The doors into and out of church will be kept open for ventilation and to avoid the need to constantly sanitise the handles;
- Fr Phil will announce the arrangements for receiving Communion;
- You should:
 - enter church by the Baptistry door and may leave by the Baptistry door or the door in the Tower porch whilst maintaining the 'social distancing' rules as directed by a steward;
 - use the hand sanitiser provided, as you enter and leave church;
 - avoid touching any items/surfaces un-necessarily;
 - take away with you any printed material that you may have picked up while in church;
 - the toilet facilities will **not** be available;

Sacrament of Reconciliation

If you wish to receive the Sacrament you should speak with Fr Phil who will hear Confessions in a suitable area outside church where social distancing can be maintained.

Offertory Basket

A Collection basket will be available at each of the doors in which you can place your Offertory Envelope or other offering.

Fairtrade

Fairtrade orders in an envelope can be placed in a basket at the back of church. Please ensure the envelope is clearly marked FAIRTRADE and with your name.
