Maundy Thursday Mass of the Lord's Supper at **7.30pm**

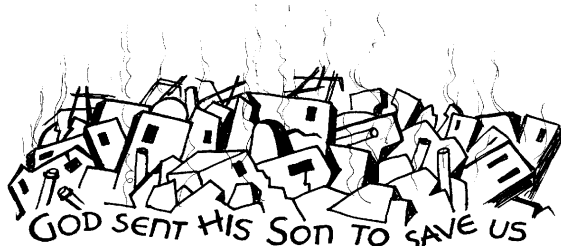
Good Friday Passion of the Lord at **3pm**
