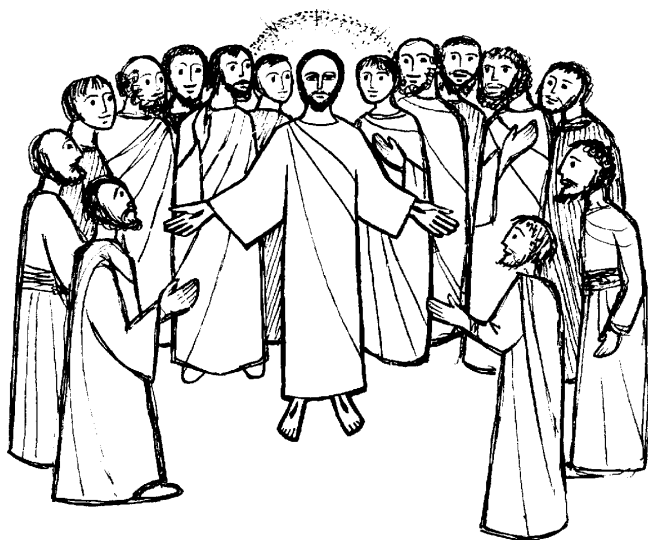
**SVP Lenten Alms** – tottalled **£961.53**, many thanks to all for your generosity and support of the SVP in their work helping those in our local community who are in need.

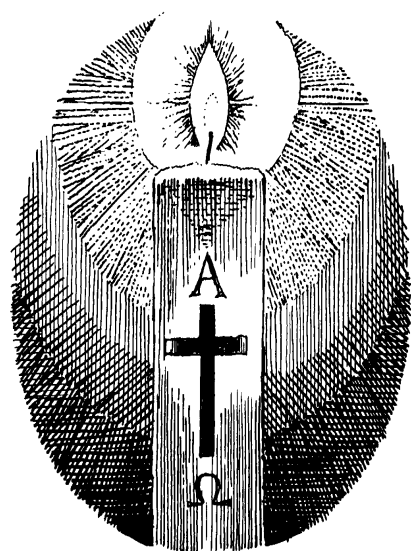
