THE CARE OF CREATION - At a time of growing concern for the care of creation, the Church brings to the environmental concerns of our time the perspective of God's creation and the place of humanity within creation. The Church across the country is taking practical steps with IFM (Inter-Diocesan Fuel Management Limited), based in our Shrewsbury Diocese and supplying all 22 dioceses and over 100 schools with 71% green energy and with a 29% carbon offset. The offset schemes include renewable boreholes in Eritrea and a new energy plant in Bangladesh using household waste (including landfill), to reduce the methane being produced and provide renewable power. IFM is also using its buying power to drive the demand for "green gas" in the UK.

Live Simply - As part of our #livesimply plan to save waste we are printing newsletters for those who are not online. This has reduced the number printed each week from 240 before Covid to 40 recently. As more people are returning to church and home deliveries are reducing this will be increased but please only take a newsletter if you do not receive one by email.
