Entrance/Exit doors will continue to be opened to provide **ventilation**.

Stewards will remain for **weekend Masses only**.

Bidding prayers will resume at all Sunday Masses.

Fr Phil will stand outside to see people after Mass.

Communion will continue under **one kind only**.
