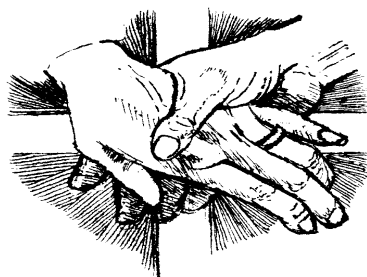
Tea and Coffee – Now that we have resumed serving tea and coffee after the 11am Mass we need people who attend Mass to join the rota providing the facility. Can you help?
