Cop26 Global Day of Action on 6th November - We can't all get to Glasgow or to London for the CAFOD action, so it's good to have a local event in Liverpool to press for climate justice. There's a poster on the noticeboard. A big coalition of groups are working together on this, both faith and secular and it is important to include young people too. The walk will start near Sefton Park at 12noon but the route has several stopping places so people can join for the whole walk or a short distance or meet at the rally points: Anglican Cathedral, Bombed out church, Church Street and Derby Square.
