**Please note there will be no Mass on Christmas Day at 6pm. Please arrive early to all Christmas Masses as there is no booking system this year*

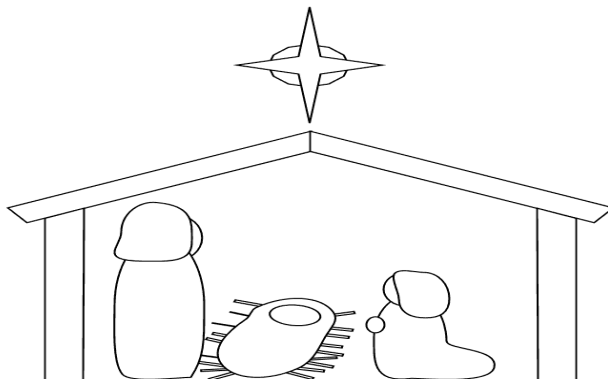
Please let people know our Christmas Mass times and encourage as many as possible to come and celebrate the birth of Jesus with us this Christmas!

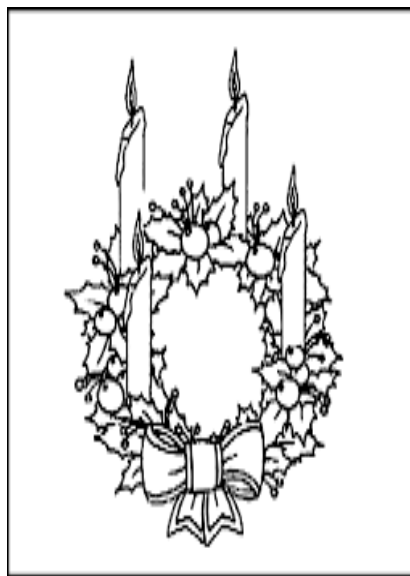
